Absent Voting

A member of the TAS Branch Council who is entitled to vote, and who will be absent during the period of the election may apply for an absent vote.

PLEASE NOTE: Completed Absent Vote Applications must reach the Returning Officer **not later than** prior to printing of ballot papers at the branch council meeting on Thursday 3 July 2025.

Should an absent application be received, the counting of the votes will be set aside until time has been allowed for the return of the absent vote.
