



Nick Saban

Football Coach, ESPY Icon Award Winner,
Commentator, Author
Monday, October 5 • 10:00–11:30 am

Nick Saban is the most iconic coach in college football history with a legacy defined by leadership, culture, and championship success. Best known for restoring the University of Alabama to dominance, Saban led the Crimson Tide to 6 national titles. With another at LSU, he has 7 National Championships overall, a feat unmatched in the poll era. His reputation as an outstanding tactician, leader, organizer, and motivator through his consistent approach and disciplined leadership known as “The Process.”

Andre Agassi

Tennis Champion, Educational Entrepreneur, Author

After turning pro at the age of 16, tennis prodigy Andre Agassi rose to international fame, earning 60 men’s singles titles, including eight Grand Slam singles championships, over a 20-year career. A former World No. 1 player, Agassi is the first male player ever to win all four Grand Slam titles and an Olympic gold medal. He was also a member of three winning Davis Cup teams. On July 9, 2011, Andre was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame.

Melissa Stockwell

2016 Paralympic Bronze Medalist, World Champion,
Veteran, Author

Melissa Stockwell was the first female American Soldier to lose a limb in Operation Iraqi Freedom. Her vehicle was hit by a roadside bomb on April 13, 2004, resulting in the loss of her left leg, above the knee. She was honored with a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star for her service. She has represented the US in three Paralympic Games and remains one of the world’s most elite Paratriathletes.

APPRENTICE APPRECIATION DAY





